THREE GENERATIONS OF BEAUMONT BEARS

2023 is the 30th anniversary of the magnet program here at BMA. To celebrate this milestone, we are looking back on a little Beaumont history. The magnet program started all the way back in 1993, 30 years ago. We will look at what Beaumont was like through the years, and hear from some people we interviewed.

We have one question for everyone first. Do you guys know Ms. Vasquez (or Ms. V)? If so, then that's a good thing because she will be an important part of this article! Mrs. V was a student at Beaumont from kindergarten through 5th grade. Now she teaches 3rd grade! She says the building is exactly the same size, but when she was younger, it felt a little bit bigger. When she was a student, 3rd grade was upstairs, not 5th! She was a Danceworks and Polka Dot member and some of her favorite teachers included Mrs. Truex (kindergarten wizard), Ms. Whelan (dance) and Mr. Grimik (dance). Mrs. V's fondest memories include coming to school with her mom (who was a teacher here) and brother and now how cool it is that she teaches here with her son! We

also interviewed Mrs. V's mom, Beth Blevins, because she was a teacher here during that same time. She explained that there were Encore classes, but not theater and STEAM. School newspapers would get printed and handed out to classes occasionally, just like we do today! Students participated in book fairs. There were field trips to amazing places. There were also class plays, but not a theater program. Mrs. Blevins described the playground being much better today than it used to be. They did have computers eventually, but not when she first started teaching. She has several fond memories but she said, "the friendships, parents, students, community members" were among her fondest. We can still relate to that today!

That's a wrap on some Beaumont history. We enjoyed interviewing Mrs. V and her mom and we hope you enjoyed the article. Beaumont's history is so cool to learn about. Many things have changed in the last 30 years, but the community spirit and creative opportunities still remain the same.

Fun fact- Ms. Whitehead started teaching at BMA the same year it became a Magnet school!
