Students can take DE coursework through any of the colleges below. Students opting to take courses on college campus must submit request to Mrs. Bell in writing & on-campus course times must work in students high school schedule. Students may be eligible to receive up to 5 DE classes for free through the grant.

Dual Enrollment (DE) Qualifications:

1. Rising Juniors or Seniors can take DE courses. Students can start taking DE courses the summer after completing sophomore year. *Summer courses must have principal approval prior to classes starting.*
2. General Education DE Courses such as English 1010 & other beginning courses, students must have: (Specific to Pellissippi)
 - a. **3.0 + unweighted GPA** (to qualify for DE Grant)
 - b. **19 + ACT Reading score AND 18+ ACT English Score** (if the course does not involve math skills).
 - c. **19+ ACT Reading score AND 19+ ACT math score** (if the course does involve math skills).
 - d. Or a **3.6 unweighted GPA**. *Note some courses will require ACT scores.

Steps to complete in meeting

1. Go to admissions website for selected school. You will apply. Select DE student. Remember the username and password you created.
2. Apply for the DE Grant

* Be sure to check your email for confirmations from college application for further steps and DE grant verification.
