WHEREAS, the Knox County Board of Education owns and had previously operated a facility known as the Oakland School (or Oakland Recreation Center) located at 3816 Oakland Drive (CLT#059IA012) within the Fountain City Community.

WHEREAS, The Knox County Board of Education is not using the Oakland School real property for any school purposes and has no intention or proposals to use such property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF KNOX COUNTY:

SECTION 1: As of September 13, 2017, the Board of Education of Knox County hereby declares as surplus the Oakland School building and recreation area real property which is situated on approximately 1.9 acres with a field and partially wooded areas as described in Attachment A (legal description within two deeds), and Attachment B (aerial view).

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall take effect from and after its passage, the welfare of the Knox County School Board requiring it.
