#### Safety Reminders from Officer Dance

Dear East Knox Families,

Our maintenance department is done removing the trees in the front of the school. Please remember that the front parking area is open from 8:00 am through 2:30 pm for visitors and/or parents who are picking up early. Between 8:00 am to 2:30 pm are the only times that you come into the bus entrance and turn back into the front parking area. There is a new sign with an arrow that points in the proper direction at the bottom of the entrance hill. *Prior to 8:00 am, you will still need to use the designated school entrance and park in the visitor parking if you are walking a child in.* If you are here for a meeting, then merge into the drop off line and remain in the line until you reach a point that you can park up front. Please do not drive against traffic during arrival or dismissal.

**The rear entrance doors are for staff entrance only.** These doors are not a public entrance during the school day. You must come to the front and press the button to be buzzed in to go to the front office.

East Knox school procedures are put into place for the safety and security of our students and staff. Thank you for helping us keep our campus safe.
